Please take advantage of them all. There has been tremendous support from our city's best asset, our residents, with regards to citizens volunteering for the different committees and commissions. We are continuing to witness the growth of TEAM WINDCREST - both city pride and citizen participation are growing. We encourage you to remain active and involved, and we promise that we will continue to modify, change and refine how we do business. As we all know: **If we stay the same, we cannot improve.**

**Firefighter Picnic Re-cap:** This was the third year that this picnic was made a 2 day event. The 1st Annual Softball game between the Fire Department and the Police Department was "entertaining." **ICSC CONVENTION:** This is held in Las Vegas every year. This year, several of the WEDC Board went, along with Council person Jim Shelton. They marketed our city to developers, franchisees and investors to encourage economic development. Several cities in our surrounding area go as well. For instance, Live Oak and Converse are two that attended this year. We have found that the money invested produces great returns. Last year, it helped us land IN-N-OUT Burger. This year, at least two deals were signed as of the time of this article – PDQ Restaurant and Buffalo Wild Wings. PDQ Restaurant will go next to the IN-N-OUT Burger at the site of the Old Frost Bank Building. Buffalo Wild Wings will be where the old Marie Callendar's Restaurant stood. **Windcrest Property Tax Rate:** Many citizens have asked the question – Are we going to see a reduction in the property tax rate again? Yes, this administration promised that we would run the city more efficiently and would encourage Economic Development. For the third year in a row, we will see a reduction in the property tax rate. **I will propose at least a 21% reduction in the City of Windcrest Property Tax Rate for this coming year.** Additionally, I will encourage the Council to vote to continue for next year the **\$5 residential permit fee and the 25% reduction of the garbage bill.** This is a testament to all the hard work by everyone on Team Windcrest.

**Develop General Master Plan Committee (Update):** Several meetings have been held and this process is moving along. Several workshops were planned and were well attended. If you were unable to attend, contact someone on the committee. Please make sure your voice is heard.

**Takas Park and Takas Park Pond:** At the time you receive this Newsletter, the Takas Park pond will be open to the public. I am confident that you will be both impressed and proud. We will still schedule a celebratory grand opening. Additionally, there will be upgrades to the playground area grounds in the next several weeks. Also, plans are being made to improve the sidewalks, lighting and benches in all the parks to match what has been done at Takas Park. You will also see improvements being made to the Civic Center and the Community Pool. These are projects of the Parks and Rec Committee. They are working hard to make the city even more beautiful, and are committed to improving the quality of life. Thank you for all their hard work.

**Street Repairs:** We are currently in the construction phase of approximately \$1 million of street repair and rebuilds. This will take several months. Pardon the dust and the inconvenience. As promised, this administration is committed to systematically repairing and/or rebuilding all the streets in the Windcrest resi-

dential area over the next 3 – 4 years. More information can be found on the Windcrest website.

**Winnbrook Estates Park:** This park is scheduled to break ground in June. It will be done in 3 phases. We look forward to seeing the completion of phase one by August 1. A big thank you goes out to the Parks and Recs Committee and to the Winnbrook Estates HOA. This is an amenity that the residents will be proud of.

**Condolences:** Unfortunately, we lose people in our community every month. This month we lost Garlene Bach. She was involved in so many areas of the city. She was a former Windcrest City Council Person who served multiple terms and was an active member in many organizations. She loved and was committed to the City of Windcrest. She was especially involved with the Women’s Club, and was instrumental in Light-up. She worked very hard for the community. She will be missed. Our condolences go out to the Bach family, and to the others who lost loved ones this month.

**Volunteering and Participating:** We need more people on the Newsletter Committee, Windcrest Citizens’ Patrol and Animal Task Force. Please call Heather Weidenbach at City Hall if you wish to volunteer. Remember that there are still places of service within the City. 

### CHILD PASSENGER SAFETY SEAT SYSTEMS


In the Transportation Code, Sec. 545.412 CHILD PASSENGER SAFETY SEAT SYSTEMS; OFFENSE a person commits an offense if a person operates a passenger vehicle, transports a child who is younger than eight years of age, unless the child is taller than four feet, nine inches, and does not keep the child secured during the operation of the vehicle in a child passenger safety seat system according to the instructions of the manufacturer of the safety seat system. An offense under this section is a misdemeanor or punishable by a fine of not less than \$25 and not more than \$250. Buckle up the children!

### TIPS FOR THE ROAD

Did you know that motor vehicle crashes are the number one killer of kids. This is because in many cases, children are either not properly buckled into their safety seats or parents don't realize that a booster seat is vital to ensuring children fit safely in their vehicle's seat belt. Don't take a chance. Have your child's safety seat inspected!



**SUMMER TIME IS HERE!** Just a few things in our ordinances you may not have known. Kids are out for the summer and I need to remind folks to tell your children that playing in drainage ditches and tunnels are not only dangerous but also a violation of city code Section 18.301. The alleys are only allowed to be used for ingress and egress from your properties. Playing in alleys or walking through alleys could result in contact by the police since your actions could be in violation of city code Section 18.301. Please remember the ordinance regarding the grass and weeds. You could be subject to receiving a court summons for not keeping up with your property maintenance.

Well maintained properties play an important role in keeping crime down; if anything else it helps increase your home appraisal value. If you have a poorly maintained home due to health or financial distress, seek out your neighborhood kids for assistance who may offer a lower price. Remember, it is highly recommended to check the references on all contractors you use for repairs.

Remember, we will be checking swimming pools throughout the city. Draining swimming pools into neighbor's properties or the street is prohibited and in some cases requires permits; check the ordinance in Chapter 22 for further assistance.

Does the District estimate meter Readings?

The Water District physically reads the meters faithfully from the 19th- 22nd of every month.

Does the previous General Manager Still work for the District?

The previous General Manager (Richard Frenzel) is working as a consultant for the District, and has been contracted through the end of the year.

Is the District planning on building An office complex?

Over the last decade the Water District has been planning on building an office complex. The District has set a fund aside to achieve this goal. Every quarter the District discuss, in a public setting, the administrative building fund.


