



Street Construction Notice

Street Improvements will be performed on the following streets starting on **MONDAY OCTOBER 7, 2019** with the work scheduled to be completed on **FRIDAY OCTOBER 18, 2019**.

1. **PATRIOT**– From Windway to Walzem
2. **WINDWAY**- From Roughrider to Walzem
3. **ROUGH RIDER DRIVE** – From Walzem to Windsor Hill
4. **ROUGH RIDER DRIVE** – From Windsor Hill to Windway
5. **CROSSWIND** – From Walzem to Windsor Hill

The work being performed is called Mill and Overlay, which involves the removal of the top layer of old asphalt, making street failure repairs and then applying a new layer of asphalt.

The work will be performed by **Texas Material Construction Inc.** under a contract with the City of Windcrest.

Traffic will remain two way throughout construction, however there will be times when the driving surface will be rough. Please obey the 20 mile per hour speed limit while traveling through the construction area.

Homeowners are asked to please park their vehicles in your driveway and not on the street during this construction period as you will always have access to your driveway. Business Owners and their customers will have access to businesses. Flagmen or Police Officers will be directing traffic.

In event there is inclement weather and work cannot be completed on the date scheduled the Contractor will return the next workday or when good weather permits to complete the work.
